Sermon Application Questions September 8, 2019

Romans 12:1-21

- 1. What will happen if we try to do the things laid out in Romans 12 independent of a deep personal understanding of the "mercies of God"? Do you ever find yourself trying to live your Christian life like that?
- 2. How committed are you to the truth that we are to pursue the Christian life *together*? How are you tempted to drift into a private, individualized Christian walk? What are the likely consequences of doing that?
- 3. Which of the two fruits of the gospel that Paul emphasizes in Romans 12 do you find more challenging to produce, humility or love? Why is that? What specific instruction from Romans 12 regarding humility or love struck most closely to home for you? Perhaps you might reread Romans 12 slowly and let God's Spirit speak to your heart about some specific area of greater obedience.
